## "No Haz" Collection Event - May 22

The North Oakland Hazardous Waste Consortium will be holding a collection event for hazardous materials that cannot be put in trash or recycling bins. The event will take place at Oakland University on Saturday May 22 between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. The

collection will be in the Foundation Hall parking lot. Materials to be collected include cleaners, oil filters, lawn/garden chemicals, mercury thermometers, wood stains, ammonia, paints, batteries, automotive fluids, and computer and electronic waste. Last year, thanks to hundreds of volunteers, this operation was extremely well-run and efficient, but because of the huge demand, lines can be long. Arrive early, and be patient. Carpooling to drop off waste can be helpful.

Three more collection events are planned on June 22, September 18, and October 2 at locations to be announced, but the Oakland University event will certainly be the


